

Blessed Bunting  
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When I found out that the need for burial items is so great that it has never been met in my area, it weighed heavily on my heart. This is what resulted from my desire to help. It was honestly inspired and given to me... and I hope that many will feel inspired to make it for charity and help many! Hugs.



Supplies:

46-peg fine guage rake (I used Lynn Markman's)  
4 ply worsted weight WHITE yarn, approximately 4 oz.  
H crochet hook  
Knit loom tool

Knit as flat piece

Weave (ski pole) wrap all pegs and ewrap 1 row. Knit off 1 over 1.

Row 2: Ewrap. Knit 1 over 1.

Row 3: Ewrap. Knit off peg 1, \* skip next peg, knit off next \*, repeat from \* to end.

Row 4: Ewrap. Knit 2 over 1 on 1st peg. Purl top 2 loops on next peg. Purl last 2 loops on same peg. \* Ewrap and knit 2 over 1 on next.

Purl top 2 loops then last 2 loops on next \* repeat between \* to end.  
All pegs now have 1 loop.

Rows 5 - 25: Ewrap and knit off 1 over 1.

Row 26: Eyelet row: Ewrap first 2 pegs. Knit off. Place loop on peg 2 onto next peg (3). Ewrap and knit 2 over 1. Ewrap and knit off to last 3 pegs. Ewrap and knit off 3rd to last peg, place loop on next to last peg. Ewrap and knit 2 over 1. Ewrap and knit off last peg.

Rows 27 - 46: (Row 27 will have 2 pegs with only 1 wrap ~ skip them until they have 2 loops) Ewrap and knit 1 over 1.

Row 47: Repeat row 26, Eyelet Row.

Rows 48 - 67: Ewrap and knit off 1 over 1.

Row 68: Ewrap and knit off 1st 2 pegs. Place loop on 2nd peg on 1st peg. Knit off and put remaining loop back onto peg 2. \* Ewrap next peg and knit off. Place loop on previous peg and knit off. Move this loop back over.\* Repeat for 14 pegs. Ewrap and knit off 1 over 1 all remaining pegs.

Row 69: Ewrap 1st 2 pegs and knit off. Place peg 2 loop on peg 1 and knit off. Move back to other peg. \* Ewrap and knit off next peg. Move loop back one peg and knit off. Move remaining loop back to peg next to work. \* Repeat for 14 pegs. You will now have 18 pegs with loops.

Row 70: Ewrap and knit 1 over 1.

Row 71: Ewrap 6 new pegs for an increase, turn and wrap again, and wrap original 18 pegs and then 6 more new pegs. Knit off the pegs with 2 loops. We have 30 pegs now with loops.

Rows 72 - 99: Ewrap and knit off 1 over 1.

Row 100. With crochet hook, slip off first 2 loops onto hook and sc. \* Remove next loop and sc \* until all loops are off. Working along side, work a hdc, 3 dc, hdc spaced evenly down to neck edge. Sl st into first st on bunting. End off and weave in end.

Row 101: Attach yarn at other neck edge and continue shell pattern across side of hat, leaving top of hat undone. End and weave in ends.

Make a ch 150 stitches long. Weave through hat just below shells, and around every 2 stitches across top of hat and back through below the shells on the other side.

Attach yarn to first row of bunting and ch 35. Weave in end. Repeat on other side and at each eyelet on both sides.

The bottom has a natural drawstring or you may make a ch and weave it through.
