



## Loom Knitted Headband

A quick an easy knit.

### DIRECTIONS

Cast on 4sts

Row 1: k

Row 2: p

Row 3: k1, m1, k to last 2sts, m1, k1

Row 4: p

Rep Rows 3-4, until you have 10sts on the loom.

\*Next row: k

Next row: p\*

Repeat from \* to \* until item measures 18 inches from cast on edge.

\*\*Next row: k2tog, k to last 2sts, k2tog

Next row: p\*\*

Repeat from \*\* to \*\* until you have only 4sts remaining on loom.

Bind off with basic bind off method.

Sew bound off edge to cast on edge.

Daisies: with contrasting color yarn, embroider 2 to 3 daisies at one of the sides.

### Lazy Daisy Embroidery Instructions:

- Thread tapestry needle with CC
- Bring needle up at inner point of petal where you want the first petal.
- Form a loop with the working yarn, push the needle back down through the same inner point. Maintain the loop shape.
- Insert the needle so that it pop ups out by the loop end (inside the petal).
- Cross over the loop and insert the needle down, pull gently on the working yarn. This loop will secure the daisy petal.

The above forms 1 petal; repeat to form more petals.

### Pattern Information

#### Materials

**Loom:** 10 peg fine gauge knitting loom by Décor Accents. Keychain sample loom used in project.

**Yarn:** Cascade Fixation. Less than 1 skein for project. 1 yard of contrasting color yarn for daisies accents.

**Notions:** knitting tool.

**Gauge:** 5sts per inch

### Abbreviations

**k**=knit

**p**=purl

**k2tog**=knit two stitches together

**m1**=make 1 (increase a stitch)
