



Pearly Satchel

A girly little bag to carry the bare essentials to that perfect date. It will fit a credit card and a lipstick. Be ready for that special date! When I was designing it, I was thinking of my prom night and how I would have liked to have something of the kind.

Pattern is available for knitting with needles and for knitting it on a knitting loom.

Enjoy!

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Needle Knit Pattern

Preparation: Before you begin, string 68 beads onto the yarn. As you knit, move them towards the working yarn end as needed.

DECORATIVE BRIM

CO 44 sts, join in the round. Place stitch marker to mark beginning of round.

Rnds 1-8: k

Rnd 9: *yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * until the end of rnd.

Rnd 10-12: k

BEADING ROUNDS

Rnd 1: *slb, k4; rep from * until the end of rnd. (11 beads slipped)

Rnds 2-7: k

Rep Beading Rnds 1 to 7: 5 times for a total of 6 beaded rounds.

BOTTOM OF SACHEL

Rnds 1-3: k

Rnd 4: *k2tog; rep all around. (22sts remain)

Rnd 5: *k2tog; rep all around. (11sts remain)

Bind off: Cut yarn leaving a 10-inch tail. Thread the yarn tail end through tapestry needle, pass the tapestry needle through each of the stitches. Cinch the end close. Weave in ends.

Pop the beads from the wrong side to the right, and set the stitches by either blocking the baggy or simply by pulling downwards.

Cord: Cut a piece of yarn about 24 inches long. String 42 beads and center them on the piece of yarn. Pass one of the ends through six (6) eyelets formed by the

Pattern Information

FINISHED SIZE:

3.5" tall by 3" wide

NEEDLES: size 5 dpns

YARN:

60 yards of sports weight yarn. Patons Brilliant in White Twinkle was used in sample.

BEADS:

138 pcs, size 6mm round bead/white pearl color. Darise Craft Designer was used in sample (bag of 750 pcs).

NOTIONS: 1 stitch marker

GAUGE:

14 sts and 22 rows= 2"

Abbreviations

k	knit stitch
rnds	rounds
slb	slip bead
bo	bind off
co	cast on
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
yo	yarn over

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k2tog. Pass the other yarn end through the six (6) eyelets formed by the k2tog. The two ends should meet at the front eyelet. String 18 beads through one of the ends, make a knot to secure the beads in place; repeat with the other end.

The 42 beads at the back will be used as a bracelet to wear the little bag around the wrist.



Loom Knitted Pattern

Preparation: Before you begin, string 68 beads onto the yarn. As you knit, move them towards the working yarn end as needed.

DECORATIVE BRIM

CO 44 sts, join in the round.
Rnds 1-8: k

Eyelet rnd: We will move the k2tog stitches before knitting the round. Move the stitches as follows (if you feel comfortable knitting the round as you do the k2tog, just go directly to the instructions for Rnd 9):

Move loop from peg 1 to peg 2.
Move loop from peg 5 to peg 6.
Move loop from peg 9 to peg 10.
Move loop from peg 13 to peg 14.
Move loop from peg 17 to peg 18.
Move loop from peg 21 to peg 22.
Move loop from peg 25 to peg 26.
Move loop from peg 29 to peg 30.
Move loop from peg 33 to peg 34.
Move loop from peg 37 to peg 38.

Rnd 9: *yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * until the end of rnd.
Rnds 10-12: k

BEADING ROUNDS

Rnd 1: *slb, k4; rep from * until the end of rnd. (11 beads slipped)
Rnds 2-7: k

Rep Beading Rnds 1 to 7: 5 times for a total of 6 beaded rounds.

BOTTOM OF SACHEL

Rnds 1-5: k

BO: Gather removal method. Weave in ends.

PATTERN INFORMATION

FINISHED SIZE:
3.5" tall by 3" wide

KNITTING LOOM:
44 peg knitting loom in fine gauge (1/4" from center to center of peg). Sample was knit on Décor Accents fine gauge XL adult sock loom.

YARN:
60 yards of sports weight yarn. Patons Brilliant in White Twinkle was used in sample.

BEADS:
138 pcs, size 6mm round bead/white pearl color. Darise Craft Designer was used in sample (bag of 750 pcs).

NOTIONS:
tapestry needle (straight end, not bent), knitting tool.

GAUGE:
14 sts and 22 rows= 2"

Abbreviations

k	knit stitch
Rnds	rounds
slb	slip bead
bo	bind off
co	cast on
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
yo	yarn over

Pop the beads from the wrong side to the right, and set the stitches by either blocking the baggy or simply by pulling downwards.

Cord: Cut a piece of yarn about 24 inches long. String 42 beads and center them on the piece of yarn. Pass one of the ends through six (6) eyelets formed by the k2tog. Pass the other yarn end through the six (6) eyelets formed by the k2tog. The two ends should meet at the front eyelet. String 18 beads through one of the ends, make a knot to secure the beads in place; repeat with the other end.

The 42 beads at the back will be used as a bracelet to wear the little bag around the wrist.

HOW TO SECTION

Knit stitch: place the working yarn above the loop on the peg. Reach with your knitting tool through the stitch on the peg (from bottom up). Hook the working yarn thus forming a loop, hold this loop with your fingertips or knitting tool. Take the original loop off the peg and place the newly form loop on the peg. Tug gently on the working yarn to tighten the stitch.

Slip a bead: Knit until you reach the point to slip the bead. Slip the bead before knitting the next stitch. The bead should be between the pegs, and towards the back (not in front of the pegs).

k2tog: move the stitch from peg to the right to peg to the left. Knit the two stitches together (lift both loops off the peg).

yo: e-wrap the peg

Preparation: Before you begin, string 68 beads onto the yarn. As you knit, move them towards the other end of the ball as needed.
