

# Toddler T-Top

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## Materials

**Knitting Loom:** Large Gauge Knitting Loom. Yellow Knifty Knitter was used in sample.

**Yarn:** Bulky weight yarn, about 120 yards. Caron Simply Soft was used in the sample.

**Notions:** Knitting tool, Tapestry needle

**Size:** 12-18 mos

**Gauge:** 10 stitches and 15 rows= 4 inches (Blocked)

## Pattern Notes:

Knitted as flat panel

Knit=Knit Stitch/Flat Stitch

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## Instructions

**Back and Front are connected at the shoulders.**

### Back

Cast on 26 stitches using chain cast on method.

Row 1, 3: Purl

Row 2: Knit

Row 4-25: Knit

Row 26: {Cast on stitches for sleeve caps}

Cast on 5 stitches at the beginning of row. (31 stitches)

P1, K30.

Cast on 5 stitches at the end of row. (36 stitches total)

Row 27-40: P1, K34, P1

Neckline opening begin.

Row 1 Neckline: P1, K10, BO 14, K10, P1

Row 2 Neckline: P1, K10, CO 14, K10, P1

Neckline opening end.

Row 41-54: P1, K34, P1

Row 55: {Bind off stitches from sleeve caps}

BO5, K26, BO5. Cut yarn leaving a 6 inch tail. (26 stitches remaining)

Join yarn at peg 1.

Row 56-77: Knit (22 rows)

Row 78: Purl

Row 79: Knit

Row 80: Purl

Bind Off

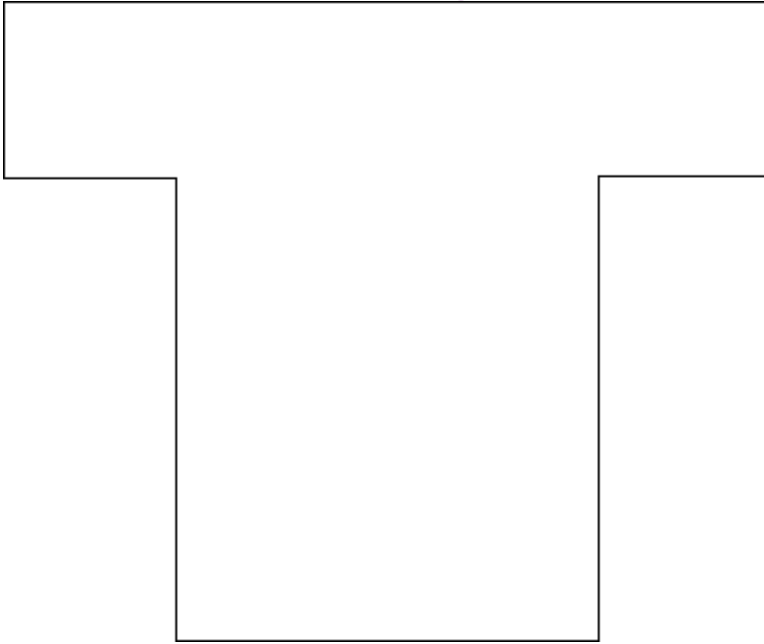
## Assembly

**Block lightly before seaming.**

Fold the item in half, with wrong sides facing. Mattress stitch seam the sides of the blouse.
