



There are two types of flowers that will make me swoon and sigh, tulips and calla lilies. When I got married, I was able to have a few calla lilies around to make my day extra special but it was too early to have tulips. Although I missed these beautiful flowers at my wedding, they now grace my front yard and every year, I am able to see them and enjoy their beauty. The stitch pattern in these socks form a little cup that remind me of my beloved flowers.



I hope you enjoy them!

Materials

- **Loom:** 64 peg extra fine gauge knitting loom. 9" Adult EFG by Decor Accents was used in sample. To re-create the pattern, you will need a knitting loom with a peg count multiple of 4.
- **Yarn:** 350-400 yards of sock weight yarn. Knit Picks Dye your Own was used in sample.
- **Notions:** knitting tool, tapestry needle, 2 double pointed needles size 1

Gauge: 18 stitches and 24 rows=2" in stockinette stitch (knit all rows)

Size: Shown in 8" foot circumference

Pattern notes: Clockwise direction around knitting loom

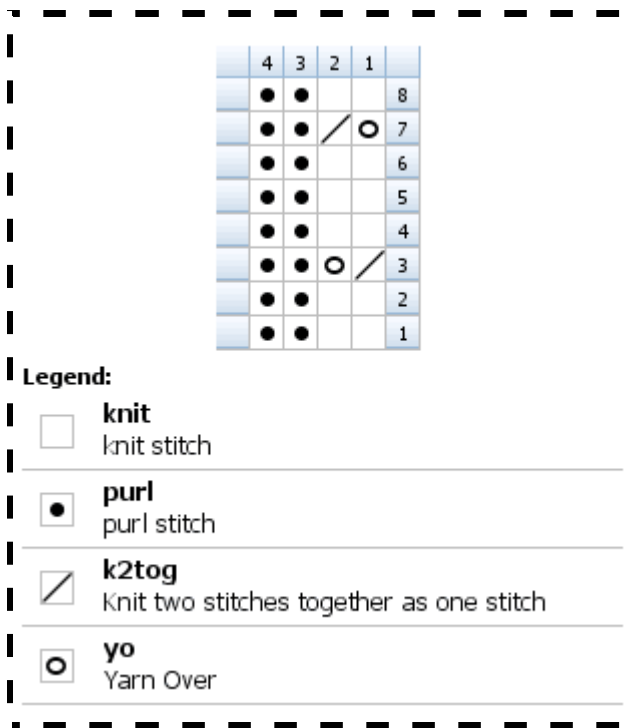
How to:

K2tog: Move stitch from the left peg to the right peg; knit both stitches together.

Example: (going clockwise around the loom) Pegs 1 and peg 2, have 1 loop each. Move loop from peg 1 over to peg 2, peg 1 is empty, knit both stitches on peg 2 as one.



YO: E-wrap peg



Directions:

Cast on 64 stitches with the chain cast on method or the cable cast on method, join in the round.

Cuff

Rnd 1-8: *k2,p2; rep from * to the end of round
Leg

Rnd 1: *k2,p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 2: *k2, p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 3: *K2tog, yo, p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 4-6: *k2, p2: rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 7: *yo, k2tog, p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 8: *k2, p2: rep from * to the end of round

Repeat Leg Rnds 1-8 until item reaches 6 inches. End of a Rnd 8.

| k2tog | Knit 2 stitches together to create a decrease |
| yo | Yarn over |

Heel: Done as a flat panel using short-rows.

End Heel

Foot

Rnd 1: k34, p2, *k2,p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 2: k34, p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 3: k34, p2, *K2tog, yo, p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 4-6: k34, p2, *k2, p2: rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 7: k34, p2, *yo, k2tog, p2; rep from * to the end of round

Rnd 8: k34, p2, *k2, p2: rep from * to the end of round

Repeat rounds 1-8 until sock sole measures 1.5 inches less than desired length.

Knit 2 rounds of stockinette stitch

Toe

Repeat Heel area

Bind Off: After the heel instructions have been repeated on the toe area, the toe is ready to be closed. Place half of the stitches on a dpn (1-32) and the other half on a second dpn (33-64). Cut the working yarn leaving a long tail to use to close the toe area. Use the kitchener stitch to close the toe.

Finishing: Weave all yarn tail ends. Block lightly.
